Child Protection Policy Safeguarding Young People and Children

Amongst the activities of Wheatley United Reformed Church we seek to serve the needs of young people.

In doing so, Wheatley United Reformed Church takes seriously the welfare of all young people and children who come onto its premises or who are involved in its activities.

Wheatley United Reformed Church aims to ensure that they are welcomed into a safe, caring, Christian environment with a happy and friendly atmosphere.

We at Wheatley United Reformed Church are aware that neglect, physical, sexual or emotional abuse of young people and children happens from time to time and that if we are ever suspicious that this has taken place we undertake to report it.

Wheatley United Reformed Church recognises its responsibility to implement, maintain and regularly review procedures which are designed to prevent and to be alert to such abuse.

Wheatley United Reformed Church is committed to supporting, resourcing and training those who work with young people and children and to providing supervision.

Wheatley United Reformed Church would be committed to maintaining good links with the statutory child care authorities relevant to each situation.
